

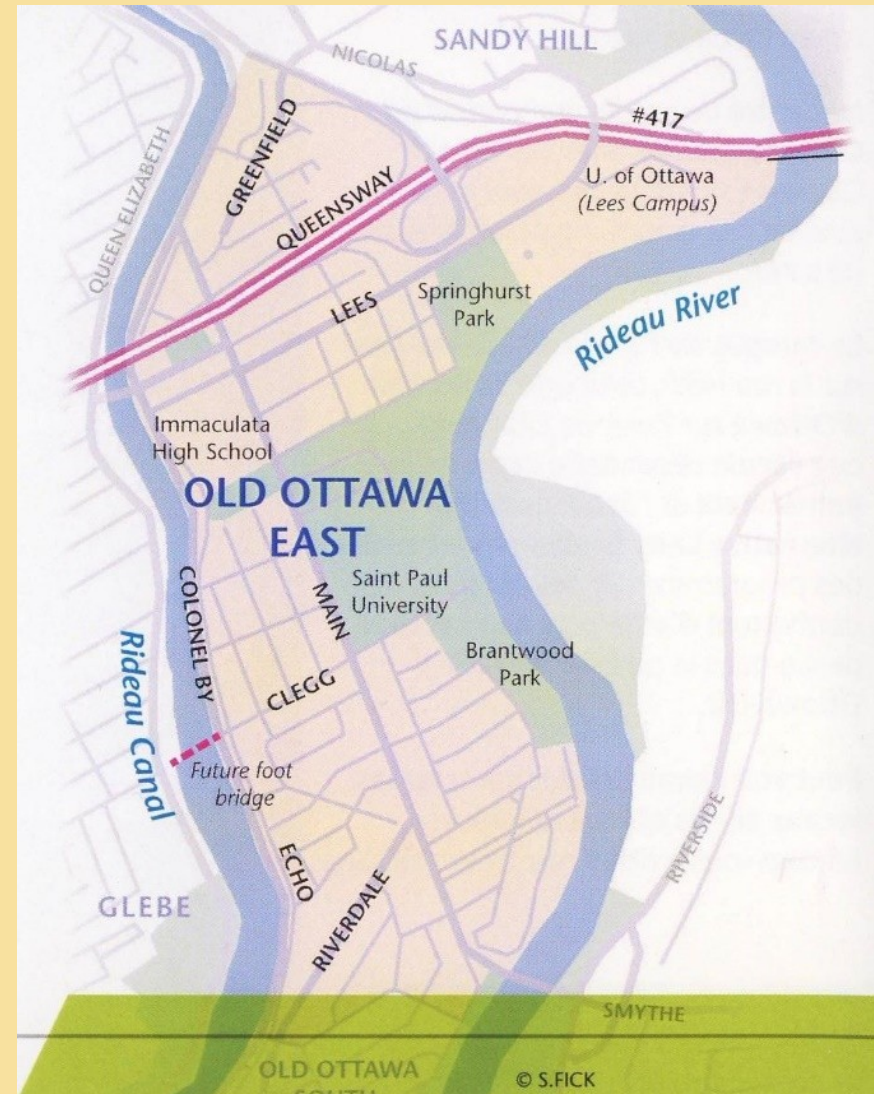

Lansdowne Park

- Lansdowne Park now a major OOE park because of Flora
- OOECA part of “Community Consultation Group” but no meetings held
- City approved more favorable partnership deal for OSEG
- OSEG/City pushing for new northside stands and arena with housing tower(s) above
- No estimates of cost or source of funds
- Very little information sharing - let alone substantial consultation - despite initial project approval almost a year ago
- Improvements to Aberdeen Square put on hold
- Through traffic continues to undermine pedestrian/cyclist comfort and safety
- Key maintenance required for Aberdeen Pavilion and Horticulture building.
